Welcome back to Term 2. It has been wonderful to feel some dry season weather recently.

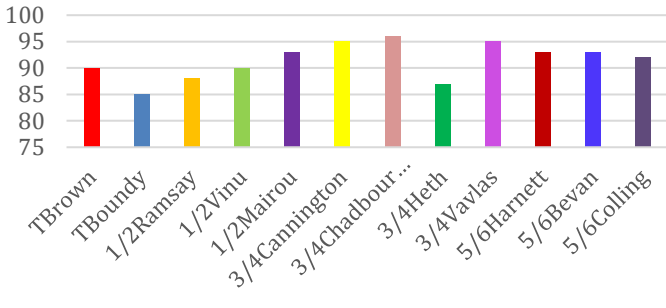

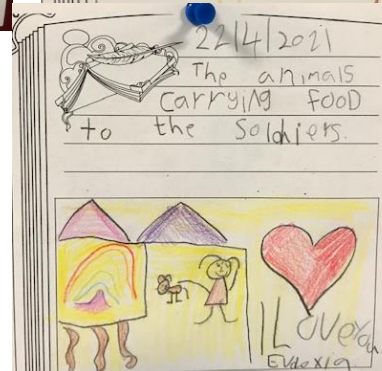
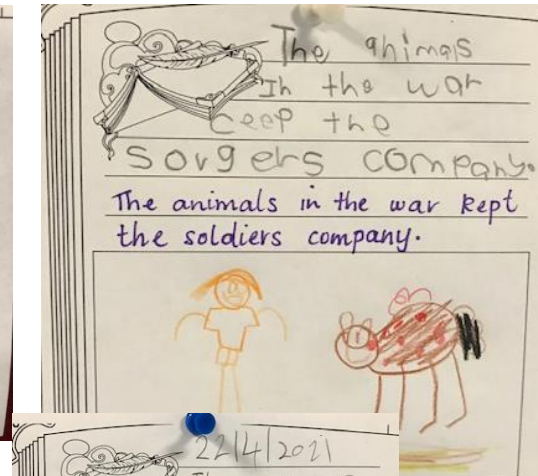
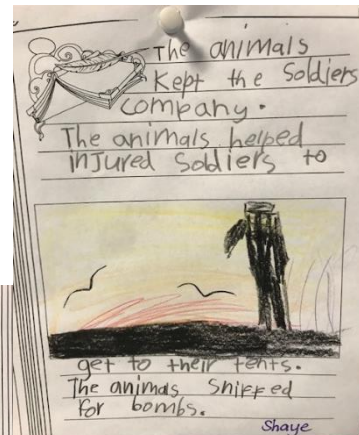
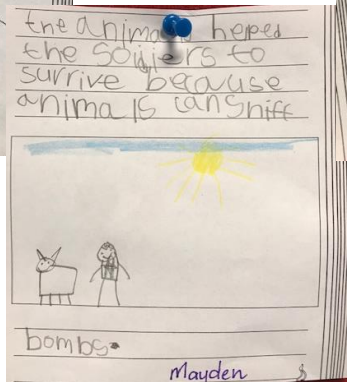
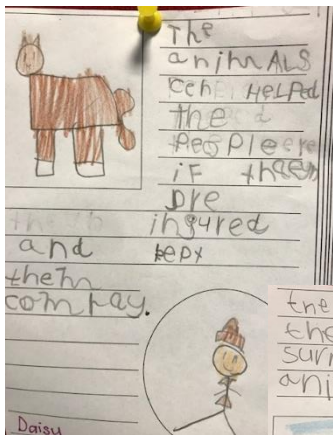
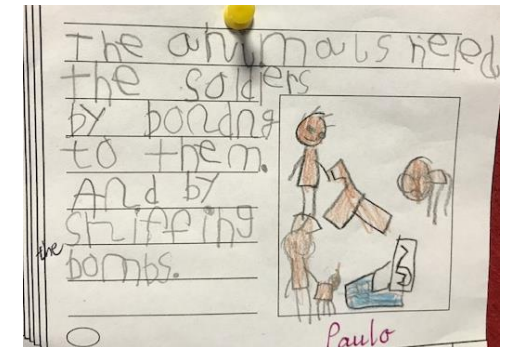
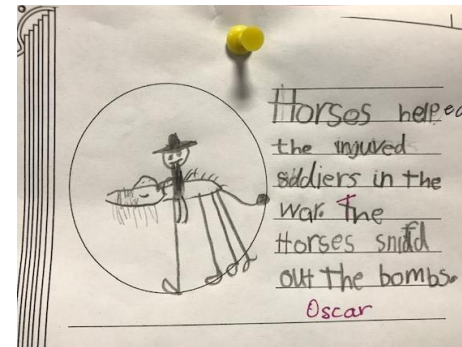
Year 1/2 Vinu

## Top End Oral Health Service

**All children** in the **Northern Territory**, aged 0-18 years, with a current Medicare card and still at school, are eligible for **free dental services** through Top End Oral Health Service.

Your children can visit any of our 12 school-based dental clinics in the Darwin region from age 0 until they finish primary school (year six).

Once your child starts year seven they must be seen at one of the community dental clinics (Darwin, Palmerston).
