This week, we have sent home contact details. Please take the time to review these and if any details have changed, please update them on the form and return to the front office so we can ensure our records are up to date.


Our whole school attendance has continued to be 89% for the year to date. We have 6 classes with attendance of 90% or more for the year so far.


