

WHAT ARE WE LEARNING? YEAR 3.4 XU

Year 3.4 Xu baked Anzac biscuits to commemorate ANZAC Day.

Anzac biscuits are a traditional biscuit. They were sent to soldiers serving overseas during World War I as a source of food and a symbol of support from home.

ANZAC BISCUITS a classic recipe INGREDIENTS

1 cup rolled oats 1 cup plain flour

25g butter

2 tablespoons golden syrup

1 cup brown sugar 1/2 cup coconut

1 tablespoon water 1/2 teaspoon bicarb soda

TOMAKE

- Preheat oven to 180°, fan forced.
- 2. Combine oats, sifted flour, sugar and coconut in a bowl.
- 3. Combine butter, golden syrup and water in a small saucepan, stir constantly over medium heat until butter is melted.
- 4. Stir in soda.
- 5. Stir mixture into dry ingredients.
- 6. Place rounded tablespoons of mixture 5cm apart onto baking paper covered oven trays.
- 7. Bake in oven for 20 mins, cool on trays.
